Namibia

Leather Category II

Namibia is a barrel-dyed thick cowhide leather from European bulls and is 1.4 - 1.6 mm thick. The skin surface is retained, but is embossed after tanning and pigmented with water-soluble colours. This makes the surface more even and natural features are less prominent. Liquids only penetrate the leather slowly and can be easily wiped up shortly after they are created. Namibia is hard-wearing and lightfast. It also has good abrasion values and high tear resistance. The natural embossing shows the distinctive grain structure of thick leather. In normal use, regular vacuuming with the upholstery nozzle or a slightly moistened cloth is sufficient for wiping. Do not use steam cleaners. Protect from direct sunlight and light. The upholstered furniture should be treated with the recommended care product at quarterly intervals.
